Priority 1 – Vehicle Damage & Imaging

◆ Replaces EMS (Vehicle Damage Portion)

- One standard for small and large scale systems
- Technical Work is complete for Damage portion
- Technical Work is in process for Imaging portion
- ◆ Imaging completion in 4th Quarter 2004



Priority 2 – Certification

 Certify and Validate that the implementation of the software application's interchange documents is in compliance with CIECA standards and implementation guidelines, i.e., meets the standards.

Certification for XML messages

- ♦ Completion in 4th Quarter 2004
- ◆ Certification to begin in 2005.



Priority 3 – Industry Resource Center

- Develop a web-based facility that will serve as a portal to Collision Repair Information.
- Develop a searchable knowledge-base with Subject Matter Coordinators monitoring.
- ♦ 1st Quarter Results

- Priority 6: PDR (Paintless Dent Repair) Reporting Standards
 - Enhance Vehicle Damage message to ensure PDR data is reported consistently.
 - ♦ Completion in 4th Quarter 2004



Priority 7 – Automated Procurement

- Multi-year Project
- Scope includes Part and Materials; OE, Aftermarket, and Recycled
- As large an impact on the industry as the EMS standard
- Initiated by Repairers and Chaired by Repairers
 - First CIECA project to be completely run by Repairers
- ♦ Goal is to implement one phase in 2004
